Recorded video presentation guidelines

Online presenters are required to upload a recorded video presentation via **YouTube**. During the conference, the recorded video will be played. However, the presenter still needs to be virtually available during the Question and Answer (Q&A) session, which takes place after the presenter's video presentation has been played.

Details of recorded video presentation:

- Duration of recorded video:
 Oral presentation: 8-10 mins
 (Please follow strictly the allocated duration)
- File format of recorded video: MP4
- Video title: ITEC2022.PaperID.Presenter_Name.mp4
- Description:
 Paper Title
- Thumbnail:
 Front page of PowerPoint presentation
- Visibility: Unlisted

Additional requirements:

- 1. All recorded video presentations must be <u>narrated</u> with the presenter's voice, and with the presenter's face shown in a small window.
- Please use the provided presentation template as the 1st slide. The next slide is an option. Presenters are free to use their discretion.
- 3. A sample of the image recorded video presentation is provided at the next page, along with the ITEC2022 presentation template.
- 4. Recording tools such as AZ Screen Recorder (for Android) or PowerPoint Slide Show and Screencast (for Windows) are highly recommended.

Other important notes:

- Please limit the recorded video presentation between 8 and 10 minutes. The size of the recorded video should be below 200 Mb.
- 2. Please **upload** your video presentation **by the submission deadline (15 August 2022)**, so the organiser has ample time for video checking and testing.
- 3. Do perform several test runs before the actual recording to ensure that the final video and audio are clear. Ensure to avoid echoes and bad acoustics.
